*Under the authority of the Committee of Ministers, the CAHAI is instructed to examine the feasibility and potential elements on the basis of broad multi-stakeholder consultations, of a legal framework for the development, design and application of artificial intelligence, based on the Council of Europe's standards on human rights, democracy and the rule of law.*

*Its unique composition, as explicitly acknowledged in its mandate, is highly representative of the diversity of AI stakeholders.*

*The CAHAI brings together **129** representatives: beyond the **47** Council of Europe's member states, which are members of the committee, **6** observer states, **24** Council of Europe bodies, **9** international organisations, **26** internet companies and, finally, **17** human rights, civil society, and academic organisations are involved in CAHAI's activities.*
